Competition Rules: According to the IWO and Rules of New Star Trophy

Participation conditions:

Special Jumping and Jumping competition as part of the Nordic Combined

1. The start on the ski jumping hill K10/K21/K42/K60 is only possible on one of the hills.

2. The scoring is done separately for male/female.

3. 2 scoring rounds will be jumped/the 1st scoring jump is valid for the Nordic

Combined, the 1st and 2nd scoring jumps is counting for the special jump competition.

(No test/trial jump)

4. In the team jumping, each team consists of three starters, with at least one female jumper. Jumping takes place from the K60.



5. Qualified jumpers can be entered in a higher age group.

6. A double start is not possible.

Age categories:

U7 Born 2017 and younger K10

U9 Born 2015 and 2016 K10

U11 Born 2013 and 2014 K21

U13 Born 2011 and 2012 K42

U15 Born 2009 and 2010 K60

Youth Born 2007 and 2008 K60

Juniors Born 2004 till 2006 K60

Men/Women Born 2003 and older K60

If there are less than 5 starters per age categories, the organizer reserves the right to combine the age groups!

The age groups U7, youth, juniors and Men/Women do not start in the NST (New Star Trophy).

Starters of age group U9, U11, U13, who are registered in higher age groups, will be included in the ranking in the respective higher age group. A double start is not possible.

Nordic Combined: The 1st scoring jump is valid for the Nordic Combined competition.

The run takes place as a cross-country run below the Ski jumping facility.

Award Ceremony: After the competition in the ski jump run-out area

Entry fee: Up to age group U15: 3,00 €, Youth/Juniors: 8,00 €, Men/Women: 10,00 € (separated fee for Nordic Combined and Special Jump); Late registration and re-registration: 20,00 €

Start number/Bib distribution:

At the competition office 2 hours before the start of the competition

(Deposit per team € 20.00, will be refunded upon complete return of the start numbers)

Team Leader/Captain Meeting:

Catering: Tea and hot food at the ski jumps from € 5.00 and snack supplies

Parking: A parking space is provided for all teams at the ski jump tower.

There is the possibility for waxing and preparation of the jumpers for the competition.

Hygiene concept in relation to SARS CoV-2:

The regulations of the Brandenburg Infection Protection Measures Ordinance, which are current at that time, apply to the event. The corresponding hygiene concept will be prepared and published in good time before the event.

Liability: All participants and supervisors must be insured according to the DWO or IWO. The organizers point out that insurance for the competitors is compulsory.

The organizer is neither liable for accidents and their consequences nor for third party claims.

1. Risk assessment and personal responsibility of the participants:

In the "DSV-Aktiven" Declaration for obtaining their start pass, the participants have declared in detail that they are aware of the risks and dangers specific to the competition and that they



accept them. Furthermore, they have been informed that they may suffer damage to life and limb when practicing their chosen ski discipline. Finally, they have committed themselves to carry out their own risk assessment based on their individual skills, they have the confidence to safely cope with the difficulties of the route or installation and have also obliged to point out any safety deficiencies they have identified. With their start, they express on the one hand the suitability of the route, and on the other hand to be able to meet its requirements. In addition, they have expressly confirmed in the "DSV-Aktiven" Declaration that they are responsible for the material they use. These declarations are also binding for this competition.

2. Fault of the organizer and his vicarious assistants/agents:

The participant in the competition accepts, if he/she suffers damage in the competition and is of the opinion that the responsible organizer or his/her vicarious agents are at fault for this, that they are only liable regarding property damage in the event of intent or gross negligence. This declaration also applies to the legal successor of the athlete. The participant further agrees to familiarize himself/herself with the respective competition regulations. If a third party suffers damage because of his participation in the competition, he accepts that any liability may affect him alone. It is therefore in his own interest to have sufficient insurance cover.

Privacy/ Data protection:

1. We, WSV1923 Bad Freienwalde e.V., Berliner Straße 97, 16259 Bad Freienwalde, represented by the "Board of Directors", are responsible for the processing of your personal data. Please send all your requests, suggestions and questions to: info@wsv1923.de or to the above address.

2. When registering for the Special Jumping and Nordic Combined sporting event in Bad Freienwalde, we collect the following categories of data or the following personal data from you: Personal master data (first name, last name, year of birth, and if applicable nationality, club affiliation) and contact details (telephone number, email address) from you directly or from your national association if you register through them or are registered with us by them.

3. Your data will be processed to fulfill the sporting event contract to which you are a party. For this purpose, it is necessary to identify you in order to check the payment of the entry fee, your eligibility to start and the existence of the insurance cover and, if necessary, to contact you for queries, to allocate you a start/bib number, to organize and carry out the entry, the

competition, the accompanying program, accommodation and/or catering as well as other event-related services. Only for the purpose of publishing lists of results and award ceremonies, your personal data (first and last name, year of birth) and your club affiliation will be published. The legal basis for this processing is Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR/ DSGVO. For the promotion of our association's purposes, for reporting in association media, in the press, on



the radio or on the internet or for economic or idealistic interests of the sports organizer and/or sports associations, the processing of your personal master data or of photo/video recordings of you during your participation in the above-mentioned event may be necessary pursuant to Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR/DSGVO.

4. Your personal data will be processed by our contractors and, if necessary, passed on to hotels and tour operators, to regional associations if applicable, to the German Ski Association e.V., to insurance companies, authorities, press organs and, if applicable, to the sports organizer. We do not transfer your data to third countries or international organizations.

5. Your personal data will be deleted as soon as the purpose of storage has ceased to apply and there are no retention obligations (including the standard limitation period for contractual claims pursuant to § 195 BGB, 3 years; Retention of invoices, 10 years).

6. You have the right to request information from us at any time in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR/DSGVO about the personal data stored about you, as well as its origin, recipients or categories of recipients to whom this data is passed on or disclosed, the purpose of storage and processing, the planned storage period and the automated decision-making carried out by us. Furthermore, you have the Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR/ DSGVO), the Right to erasure ("right to be forgotten") (Art. 17 GDPR/ DSGVO), the Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR/ DSGVO) or the Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR/ DSGVO) and the Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR/ DSGVO). Furthermore, you have the Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR/ DSGVO). The competent authority is [State Commissioner for Data Protection of the respective federal state] or a supervisory authority responsible for your place of residence. We deliberately refrain from automated decision-making.

7. The provision of your above-mentioned personal data is necessary for the conclusion of the contract. If you do not provide your data, participation in the competition will not be possible.
